



## ADMISSIONS POLICY

At Cornerstone Christian School, we *partner* with parents in Christian education. We believe a parent's role in child development is both pivotal and comprehensive to spiritual, moral, intellectual and physical development. Few would dispute the significance of preserving a Godly home. As Christians, we are called to "start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old, they will not turn from it" (Proverbs 22:6). We view our role in your child's education as a shared responsibility across the Christian home and your church. Therefore, at least one parent, preferably both, of children admitted to Cornerstone Christian School must:

1. Affirm a personal faith in Christ as their Savior and Lord; and
2. Demonstrate a commitment to and participation in a local church.

At Cornerstone Christian School, we endeavor to meet the needs of Christian families and do so with a sense of responsibility and integrity. Students will be admitted to Cornerstone Christian School based on:

1. The school's ability to provide an education program that will benefit the child. Therefore, an admissions assessment is given to gauge readiness and placement for our K-8 program.
2. Reasonable expectations that the student will support and comply with Cornerstone Christian School's standards of Christian character, mutual respect, and common courtesy.
3. An understanding that students requiring special support services will be considered on an individual basis and must be able to perform in a regular classroom.
